Two classrooms will be paired up and each class will create a monster using “Monster Match Approved” materials.

The class will then write a description of their monster and post it online for their partner class. Each class will recreate the other class’ monster by following the posted directions.

Both classes will meet via videoconference to compare the original monsters with the recreated monsters. This project will enable students to improve their writing and math skills. They will also practice following directions and speaking skills.
