



## Timeline for Snowmen at Night Project K-2

- **December 11<sup>th</sup>:** The partner list will be emailed to each participant. You also receive the date and time of your videoconference.
- **By December 20<sup>th</sup>:** You should have contacted your partner. If you have tried to contact the other teacher but they have not responded by January 15<sup>th</sup> then please contact Kim Wienken or Michele Lyles.
- **December 16<sup>th</sup> – January 13<sup>th</sup>**
  - Read the book *Snowmen at Night* to your class. Here is a link to a digital copy if you do not have access to the book. <http://www.wegivebooks.org/books/snowmen-at-night>
  - With your class create a snowman. Please use only Snowmen at Night approved materials: paper plates, cotton balls, construction paper, butcher paper, newspaper, white garbage bags, balloons, cups, markers, crayons, string, glue, tape, drinking straws, aluminum foil, glitter, pipe cleaners.
  - Write a description of your snowmen to send to the other class.
  - Write a short story about what your snowman likes to do at night.
  - Write three clues about what your snowman likes to do at night to help the other class guess.
- **By January 14<sup>th</sup>:** Email your partner your snowman description and three clues.
- **By January 24<sup>th</sup>:** Guess what the other classes snowman likes to do at night. Using the description provided by the other class create the other classes snowman.
- **Week of January 27<sup>th</sup>:** Meet via videoconference and share with the other class your guess and the snowman you created using their descriptions.
  - Some questions to keep in mind when creating the other classes snowman:
    - Which descriptive words helped your class create the snowman?
    - What would have helped your class when creating the snowman?
